

Taking an Online Assessment (for students)

Teachers can manage students' accounts/password resets by going to **Settings>SIS Data>Classes**. Just click on the "Person" icon to pull open the class roster, switch the "Show" filter (see below) to "Enrolled Students Only" and passwords can be created and/or reset.

To take an online assessment, students must:

1. Log into eDoctrina with their username and password.
2. Select the assessment from the appropriate list and then click "Start Test."

Before being taken to the test, students will receive a pop-up, saying they are not allowed to navigate away from the assessment screen.

To select an answer, simply click the mouse over the answer choice.
1st Click: Blue check is the selected answer.
2nd Click: Gold check is the selected answer, but indicates student will need to go back and re-check before finishing assessment.
3rd Click: Unselects and leaves the question unanswered.

Navigate directly to specific questions. Navigation buttons are color coded:
Blue: Already answered.
Gold: Answered but student will need to come back and confirm answer before finishing test.
Grey: Question not yet answered.

When the student is finished with the test, they will click the "Finish test" button on the upper left hand side of the screen.

If they have any questions that are still highlighted in gold, they will receive this message:
