Library Lunch Club

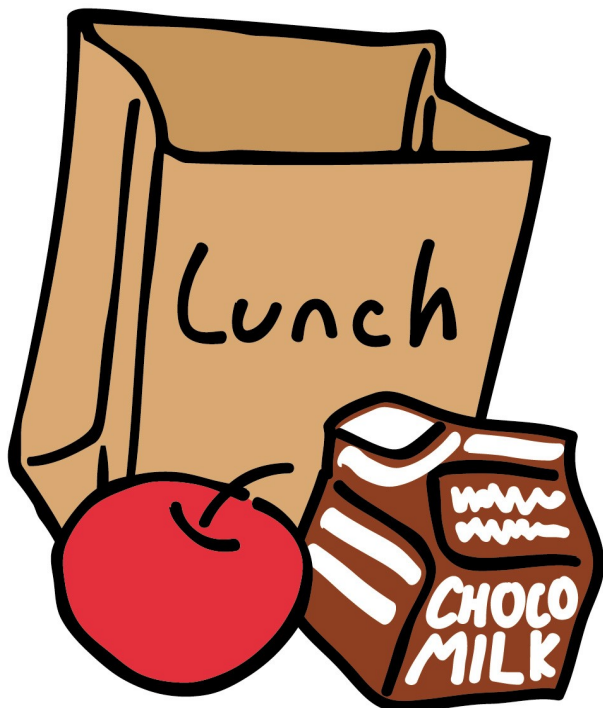

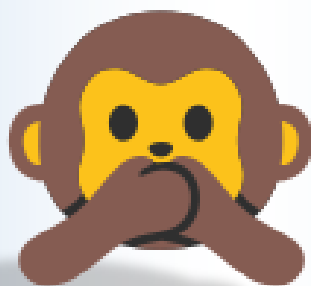

We start our fun events likes our winter Olympics

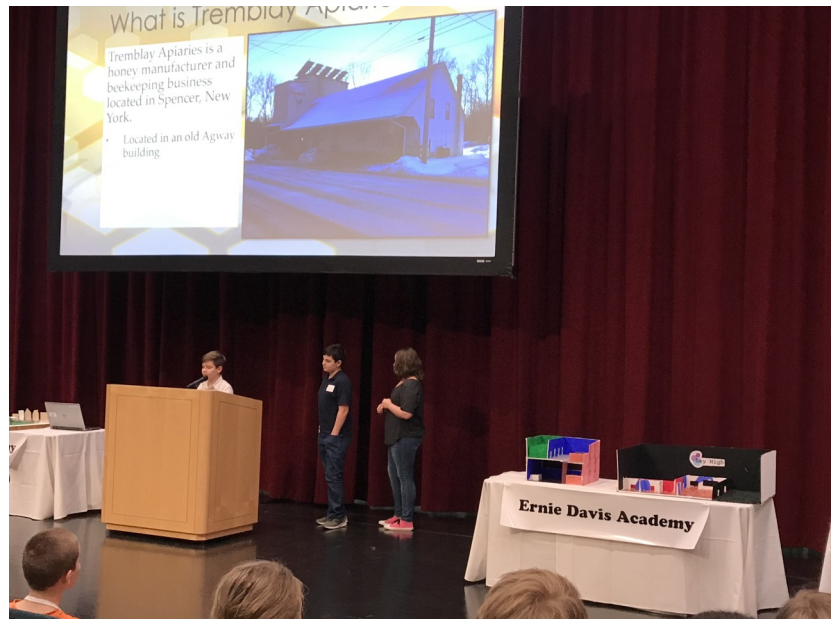

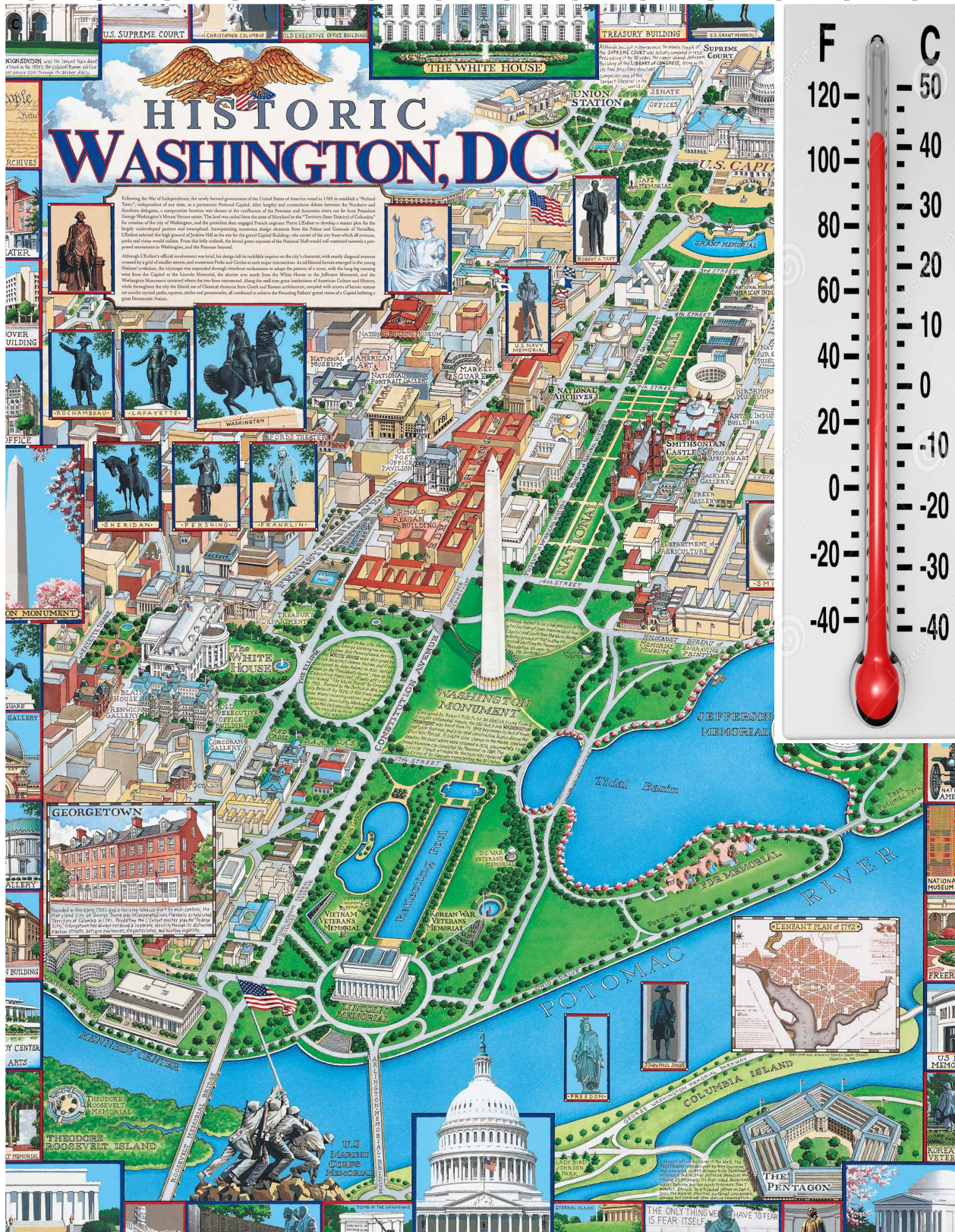

2:50. You get lots of different snacks.

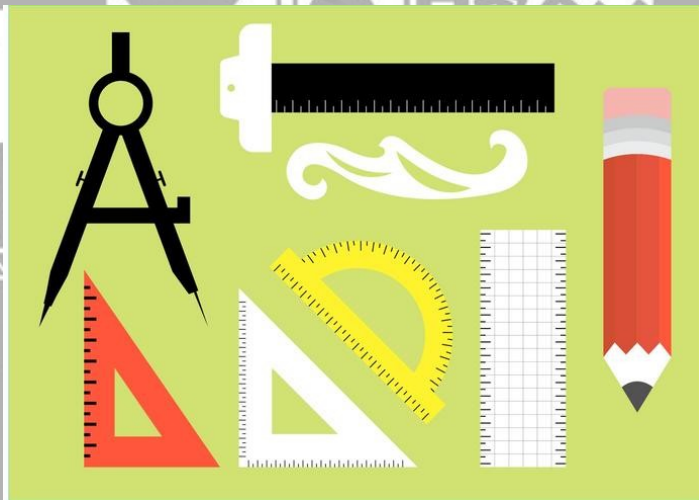

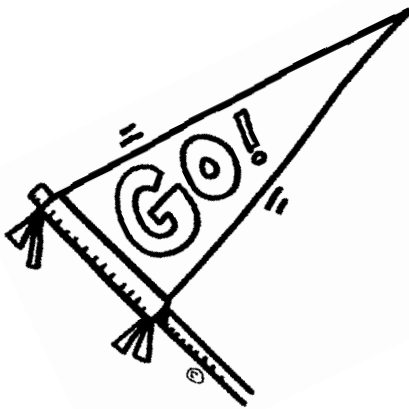
