
Mystery - Book Cube Book Report Directions




- 1. Choose a Mystery book for this month's book report.
- 2. Be sure to have it approved by Mrs. Rosno before
- 3. Complete the 5W's & 1 H Worksheet while reading your book. Be as detailed as possible as it will help you when creating your book report.
- 4. Next, find a cube shaped tissue box. If you are unable to find a box, please ask as soon as possible, so we can help you find one!
 - *Grown-ups, if you have any extra empty cubed tissue boxes at home, please don't throw them away, we would love to take them off your hands!
- 5. Measure the faces of your tissue box and cut out 6 pieces of construction papers, color can be the same or different.
 - We have construction paper at school if you do not have any at home! You can also use white computer paper.
- 6. At the top of each of the 6 pieces of construction paper please neatly write the following: (Use the 5W's & 1 H Worksheet to help you)
 - Piece 1: Title, Author, and Your Name
 - Piece 2: Who?
 - Piece 3: What?
 - Piece 4: When? & Where?
 - Piece 5: Why?
 - Piece 6: How?



- 7. You may type or hand write your responses to each question. Be sure to answer the question in complete sentences with enough detail. The goal is to showcase your understanding of the mystery!
- 8. To improve your project, add a picture to each piece of paper.
- Glue each square piece of paper onto your box. Order doesn't matter. 9.
- 10. Using your 5W's, write a SUMMARY of your book. (This does not have to be longer than a paragraph, however, be sure to use the rubric to help guide your writing.)
- 11. The Book Report is due: Friday, November 3rd.



We will have class time to work on your project, however, if you do not use your time wisely, and the deadline is quickly approaching, you may have to complete some work at home!
